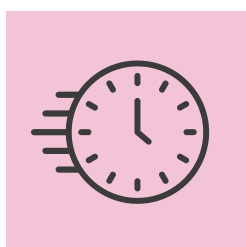

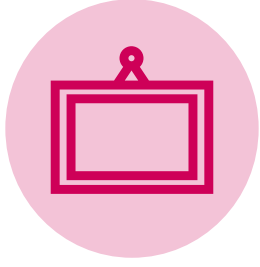

HOW TO HANG YOUR ART



Choose the right artwork for the space

Consider the room's mood: for calmness, choose soft colors and simple art. For energy, go with bright colors or bold abstracts.



Select the perfect spot

Place art where the eye naturally lands – above a sofa, bed, or large wall. Size it to nearby furniture (e.g., 2/3 the sofa's width) and avoid direct sunlight to prevent fading.



Measure and plan

Hang art with its center 57 – 60" from the floor – the average eye level. Above furniture, leave 6 – 8" between the frame and furniture.



Install the hardware

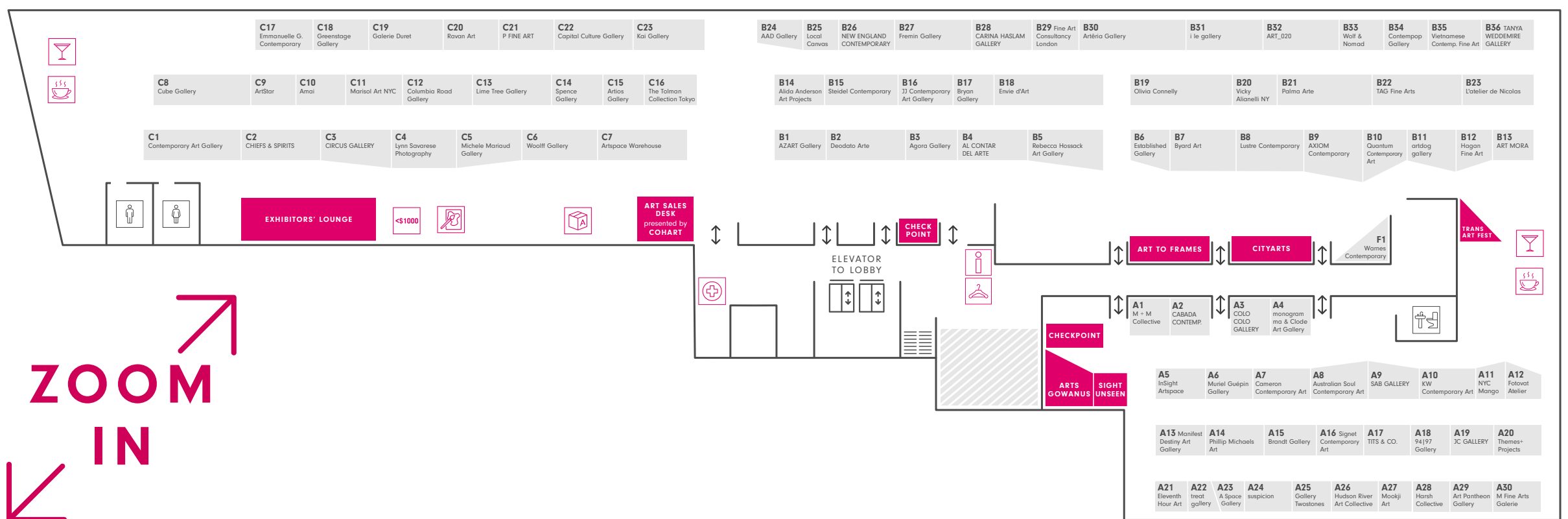
Use D-rings and wire for heavier art. Saw tooth hangers or nails for lighter pieces. Check the back of your artwork before proceeding.



Hang the artwork!

Mark your spot lightly with a pencil. Install the hook, nail, or screw where you've marked. Hang the artwork and use a spirit level to check alignment. Adjust as needed until it's perfectly straight.

FLOORPLAN

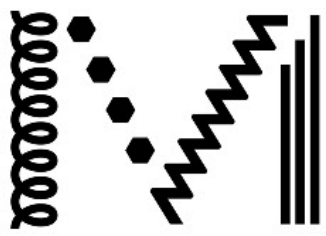
